I have been looking forward to this November for months! On November 26<sup>th</sup>, when we will be joining other Americans by giving thanks to God for the many blessings we have received from Him, my immediate family will also be celebrating our oldest son, Seth's 40<sup>th</sup> birthday! Lynn and I are looking forward to celebrating this milestone in his life, along with Aaron, our youngest son (who will turn 37 two days later), his family, and Seth's family. We are very thankful for your prayers, support, and ability to gather together from different parts of our country to celebrate.

Earlier this week, on October 26<sup>th</sup>, I discovered another reason to give thanks to God! I was informed by my doctor's nurse that the monitor I had been wearing on October 24<sup>th</sup> recorded that my heart had stopped beating for 6 seconds, took a beat, and stopped for another 7 seconds when I had fainted at home. In order to prevent future fainting episodes (which I had done earlier, while teaching confirmation on September 30<sup>th</sup>) she asked me to go to St. Joseph's Emergency Room because I would probably need a pacemaker. Thankfully, I was admitted to St. Joseph's hospital that morning. The following day the cardiologist inserted the device and the leads. The pacemaker will keep my heart pumping when other parts of my body tell it to stop! I give thanks to God for all of the medical personnel and other employees at St. Joseph's who provided excellent care for me and for my wife Lynn. I returned home on Wednesday to recover and will continue to do so for several more days.

I'm thankful for all of your prayers, encouragement, and support. In addition, I am thankful for our excellent staff at church as they carry out their responsibilities and some of mine. I also rejoice that my good friend, Rev. Kevin Froelich will be assisting with the liturgy this weekend, which allows me to rest at home over the weekend.

This past weekend, my sermon was based on Psalm 46. After reading verses 1-2, <u>God is for us a refuge and strength, as a help in troubles, He is readily</u> <u>found. Therefore, we will not fear when the earth shakes and when the</u> <u>mountains rock in the heart of the sea</u>, I said the following, "We know our troubles. They can strike at any time and destroy any sense of stability we may have had. The images of the earth shaking and the mountains rocking into the heart of sea illustrate what is or could be happening in our lives or in the lives of those we love. Your world may be falling apart. You may be wondering where help can be found. Even with all these things going on in our lives it is important we hear and believe what the Psalmist confidently writes, Therefore, we will not fear.</u>

Obviously, my life has changed in the past few weeks and months. All of our lives have changed in one way or another during this time. Yet, there is One who has not changed - our amazing God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit! His love endures forever! I hope and pray that you will join me in giving thanks to God for all the blessings He has given us, including the ones that challenge our confidence and hope! He promises to be with us always! Let us continue to give Him thanks and praise!
